COUNTY CDC TO HOST 2ND ANNUAL JOB FAIR AT WILLOWBROOK-AREA AFFORDABLE HOUSING SITE

Over 30 employers to staff booths at October 3rd event open to housing development residents and general public

EVENT:

The Los Angeles County Community Development Commission (CDC) - which serves as the region's Housing Authority -- is hosting the 2nd Annual "Making a Difference" Job Fair at its 300-unit Ujima Village affordable housing site, located in the Willowbrook-area. The fair is being held in partnership with County Supervisor Yvonne Brathwaite Burke, the County Department of Public Social Services, the state Employment Development Department, and the Larson Training Center (a business and vocational school based in Carson).

Last year's job fair drew over 200 individuals, and a larger group of attendees is expected this year. Over 30 employers are expected to staff booths. These employers include Home Depot, the LAPD, Sears, Harbor Occupational Center, Uniforce Staffing Services, and a number of Los Angeles County departments, including the CDC. The CDC is the County's affordable housing and community and economic development agency.
